- Extended abstract (2,000 words for body text) and oral presentation
- Abstract (500 words) and poster presentation

To be considered for any of the above presentation modes, authors' must submit an abstract of 500 words to be peer reviewed.

1. Prepare Your Abstract

Abstracts must be typed in English and use a 12 point Times New Roman font with single line spacing. All abstracts must not exceed 500 words, excluding title, authors and institutions. The abstract title should be as succinct as possible. Only use capitals for proper nouns. Underline the presenting author only, do not include titles or degrees. Author(s) and institution(s), city, state and country, in capital/lower case letters, should follow the title. (see below sample)

The abstract should include the essential technical qualities of the paper or poster. No figures, acknowledgements or references are required with the abstract. The presenting author's name must be underlined.

2. Register Your Abstract

Following the instructions under the call for abstracts tab you will be asked to enter your contact details, abstract title, author(s), etc. You can submit multiple abstracts at this point.

3. Upload Your Abstract

At the end of the registration process you will be asked to upload your Microsoft Word abstract document. Authors will receive email confirmation of submission success and a follow-up email from the EABS IV Secretariat.

4. Amending Your Abstract

When you submit your abstract you will be given an Access Key – please make a note of this key. If you wish to submit a new abstract or replace an existing abstract (before the closing date of 17 February 2012) you can do so through the Speakers Zone on the website.

Please note that it is a requisite that the presenting author(s) for all accepted abstracts register for the symposium, for a minimum of one day.
