CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The Stroke Society of Australasia (SSA) 2010 Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM) has the theme “Stroke2010: Delivering 21st Century Stroke Care”.

The conference is calling for abstract to be part of its scientific programme.

Abstract Submission Information

Closing Date: Sunday, 2nd May 2010

Online submission, via the SSA web site www.strokesociety.com.au is the only method for the submission of abstracts. All abstracts submitted must be original work.

When you submit your abstract you will be given an Access Key - please make a note of this key. If you wish to submit a new abstract or replace an existing abstract (before the closing date) you can do so through the Speakers Zone on the web site.

Please note that it is a requisite that the presenting authors for all accepted abstracts register for SSA 2010 ASM.

Abstracts sent via email or facsimile will not be accepted. Abstracts must be submitted via the online submission process, as outlined below. Abstracts not meeting these criteria will be rejected.

1. Prepare your abstract.

- Abstract must be typed in plain English
- Abstract must use a 12 point font with single line spacing
- Abstract must use an Arial font
- Abstract must not exceed 200 words, excluding title, authors and institution.
- Use a structured abstract format with the following headings:
 - Background
 - Aims (or Hypotheses)
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusion (or Discussion)

- The complete title should be in bold in a 12 point font. Do not use capitals.
- Include all the authors. Underline the presenting author only, do not include titles or degrees.
- Author(s) and institution(s), city, state and country, in capital/lower case letters, should follow the title.
- Use of tables and figures is not permitted.
- References should be used sparingly.
- All abbreviations should be given in brackets after the first full use of the word.

2. Register your presentation

To submit your abstract, click on the Abstract Submission link at the bottom of this page. You will be asked to enter your contact details, abstract title, presentation type, author(s), etc. You can submit multiple abstracts.

3. Upload your abstract

At the end of the Abstract Submission process, you will be asked to upload your abstract. Your abstract must be a Microsoft **Word** format.

4. Amending your abstract

Changes should be made to your Word document and then re-uploaded using the Speaker Zone area.

Notification of Abstract Status

An acknowledgment email will be sent within 7 days of receipt of your abstract. After the review process, an email will be sent to the nominated contact for the abstract by Monday, 24 May 2010 notifying acceptance or otherwise of the abstract as the basis for a paper to be submitted for consideration as part of the conference programme.
